JUNE

While hosting a visit from David Misan the principle of Tooperang Beef, Tooperang SA and his manager Ben Denis to inspect our herd we were fortunate to have them enquire about a junior sire in Granite Ridge Tartan T531 and express an interest in purchasing him. Needless to say a successful sale was negotiated for him to enter into the Tooperangus Stud program at a price of \$33,000 with Granite Ridge retaining a semen interest.

JULY

After attending the 2023 Alice Springs Show and Show Cattle Sale and having one heck of a good time, we decided that we would attend the event again in 2024. Consequently, we made the journey in 2024 with a team of 3 bulls and a great time was had with the 3 bulls sold at auction to a top of \$9,000 for GR T606 to the Smith Family of “Tieyon Station” and GR T535 & T591 both selling to the Braitling Family of Mount Doreen Pty Ltd.



AUGUST

On the 29th of August we held our 2nd Spring Bull Sale where we offered 36 rising 2 year old bulls. Top Price of \$13,000 was received for Lot 4 Granite Ridge Toad T621, purchased by Chameleon Investments, Kingston SE, SA. The sale was well supported by existing GR clients and we were thrilled to see new faces attend and buy for the first time, 29 bulls were sold for an average \$7,404.
